<u>Classroom Activities</u> (Complete at least two activities)	
	You've Got Skills: Work in pairs to think of some special skills you have and then tell the group about your partner's skills.
	Public Profiles: Using real-world examples of social media posts, think about the information you share on the internet and the messages you send with your posts.
	Job Interview: Working in pairs, practice interviewing for a job and then share your experiences with the class.
	Giving Back: Learn about philanthropy with your group. Work together to come up with a class project and then carry out your project.

<u>Friends and Family</u> (Complete at least two activities)	
	Family Crest: Read about family crests and work with the other people in your home to design a crest to represent your family.
	Ask The Expert: Talk to an adult in your home about a skill they took a long time to learn. Then, in your program, make a poster about the person and their skill.
	When I Was Little: Talk to a friend or family member who has known you for a while about what you were like when you were younger, and answer the questions together.
	Family Bucket List: Work with someone else in your home to make a list of things you would like to do that you have never done before and do at least one of the things together.

	My Resume: Learn about resumes make a resume for yourself that represents your personal skills and experience.
	My Profile: Make a poster that you can use in your final project that represents you.
	Game Plan: Think about a difficult skill you'd like to learn and the steps you would need to take to become better at that skill. Come up with a plan and consider taking the first step.
	Three Good Things: Learn about gratitude and try thinking about some things for which you are thankful in your life. Make a poster that celebrates some of those things.
