## Instructions:

-  Are there any other languages spoken in your family? Have you learned any of those languages from them?
  
-  Did many people in your family do the same kind of job? What kind of job was it? How did they learn to do that job?
  
-  Who does the cooking in your family? Do they cook recipes that have been passed down through your family? How did they learn to cook?
  
-  Are there any items in your home that are important to your family? If so, what are they and why are they important?
