Classroom Activities (Complete at least two activities)	
	How Much Should I Make?: Work with your group to talk about what people earn for different jobs, and see if you can decide which jobs should pay the most and the least.
	Hidden Jobs: Participate in a class discussion about some things you do or use every day and the different jobs that have to exist for that to happen.
	Career Day: Listen to guest speakers talk about their jobs and ask questions to find out more about them.
	Unusual Jobs: Watch a video and participate in a class discussion about some unusual jobs.

Friends and Family (Complete at least one activity)	
	First Jobs: Talk to three different adults you know who have had a job to learn about their first job experience.
	Family Careers: Talk to an adult in your home about some of the careers people in your family have now or have had in the past.
	Career Path: Talk to an adult you know about their career and answer some questions about their career path.

On Your Own or Small Groups (Complete at least two activities)	
	Who Would You Hire?: Look at a group of potential candidates for different jobs and decide which person you think would match best with each job description.
	References: Learn more about what references are and how employers use them when they make hiring decisions. Write a reference for a product, service, or person you like.
