You can use the questions below to help you. Then, at your program, make a poster that tells a story about the person you interviewed and their skill.

Questions:

1. Who taught you how to do your skill or how did you learn about it?
2. Is it something other people in your family also did?
3. Is it something you did for work as part of a job?
4. Do you like doing it?
5. Are there any specific tools or items you use in the skill?
6. Does the skill have any specific meaning to you?
7. If the skill involves making something, do you have a favorite thing to make?
8. Is the skill something you do with other people? Where?
9. What were the steps in learning the skill?
10. Do you still have to practice? Would you like to get even better at your skill or learn more about it?
